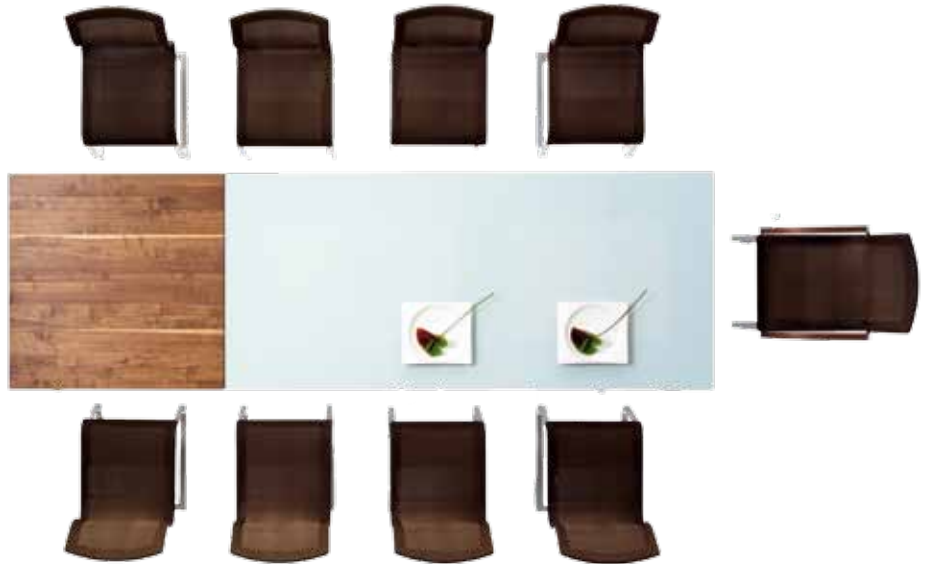

care instructions
for white
frosted glass
.....



The outward surface of white frosted glass has a slightly rough texture. Due to this rougher surface, white frosted glass tends to soil easier than hard glass surfaces. In order to maintain the appearance of white frosted glass it is necessary to be very careful.

Use silicone and/or acid-free cleaning agents for cleaning. Do not use alkaline or other acidic and/or fluorine cleaning agents.

We recommend the following care products of the company JEMAKO

Pro-cloth yellow (Item number: 2007)

cleaning cloth for wet process



Dry cloth green (Item number: 2021)

for final drying of cleaned glass surfaces



Lemon Balsam and Duopad (Item number: 5030+1210)

it helps clean and preserve surface



Please use the Pro-cloth yellow with warm water for cleaning lightly soiled surfaces. To dry the glass surface after cleaning, use the dry-cloth green by blotting wet areas rather than wiping to avoid streaks in the glass surface.

For cleaning heavily soiled surfaces, especially lime scales and grease, please observe the following instructions:

Step 1

Remove extreme dirt with warm water and the Pro-cloth yellow - misten the glass surface thoroughly.

Step 2

Using the DuoPad, rub the surface of the Lemon Balsam until it foams and then apply to the glass surface.



Step 3

Work the foam into the dirty glass surface with the DuoPad using medium to strong downward pressure.



Step 4

When the dirt is removed, thoroughly rinse the treated surface using cold water and the Pro-cloth yellow.



Step 5

Dry any remaining moisture on the glass surface with the Dry-cloth green as described previously.
